Bridge crosses reflecting pond in the middle of fastgrowing residential development

The H-Section Floor Beam Truss design reaches 40 m across the pond and features a painted finish and 3 m wide natural Douglas Fir decking. The H-Section is often selected as the most efficient superstructure for spans up to 73 m. This parallel chord truss design has its floor beams welded to vertical members of the side trusses.

Artfully poised on over 90 acres in the heart of Airdrie, Midtown provides a rare sense of openness in the midst of the city. Acting as an arrival vista, a central curving promenade juts out to the bridge, creating a lasting first impression that says "urban oasis."
